



PENALTIES WAIVED ON UTILITY BILLS

Penalties will be waived on late sewer, water and solid waste bills through July 31, 2020.

The Township Board of Supervisors voted to waive late penalties for bills due on March 31, April 30, May 29 and June 30, 2020.

Late penalties will resume on August 1. The Board also voted to extend the payment date for "face amount" real estate taxes until November 30, 2020. The original deadline was April 30.

The move is in accordance with Act 15 of 2020, implemented by Governor Tom Wolf, requesting municipalities to extend the date, as well with recent action by County Commissioners to extend the deadline for the county portion. Beginning December 1, 2020, the normal 10 percent penalty will be applied to unpaid bills. Both moves were made to ease the financial burden Township residents may be facing due to the coronavirus pandemic.

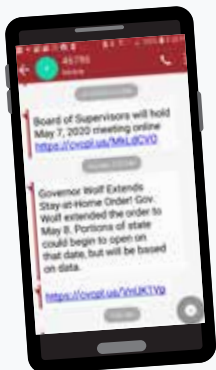
