GRADING PERMIT SITE INSPECTION CHECKLIST

Notify Cranberry Township Engineering Department at (724) 776-4806, extension 1134 twenty-four (24) hours prior to the following:

- Initiation of site work
- Grading of detention facility(s)
- Installation of detention facility(s) pipes/structure(s)
- Installation of storm sewers
- Installation of subbase
- Installation of pavement

With notification, the Township shall contact responsible party relative to the construction stages that will require Township inspection of the Engineering staff.

The Township Engineering Department should also be notified should any situation arise that may require significant modification and/or revision of the approved grading and/or site plan.
